<u>PROPOSED ACTION</u>: Resolution: Approving and Authorizing the Executive Director to Assign a Professional Services Agreement with Mandiant, Inc. to Google LLC, and Finding that the Proposed Action is Exempt Under the California Environmental Quality Act. (Technology and Innovation)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: This action consents to the assignment of a Professional Services Agreement for on-call cyber security consulting, incident response, training and support, (collectively, cyber security resource subscriptions) from Mandiant, Inc. (Mandiant) to Google LLC (Google). The request for assignment is necessary after Google acquired Mandiant.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS

In March 2022, the Port entered into a Professional Services Agreement with Mandiant to provide one year of on-call cyber security consulting, incident response, training and support, (collectively, cyber security resource subscriptions) for the Port's technology environment.

In March 2023, the Port entered into a supplemental agreement to extend services for three additional years, ending in March 2026. In April 2024, Google announced that it had acquired Mandiant and was notified that existing agreements would be assigned to Google as of October 1, 2024.

The proposed assignment will result in the continued provisioning of on-call cybersecurity consulting, incident response, training and support services; cybersecurity resource subscriptions to the Port under the agreements.
