



Draft Seaport Air Quality 2020 and Beyond Plan
Notice of Public Review and Comment
(Date of Notice: Friday, June 29, 2018)

The Port of Oakland is inviting public comments on its new draft air quality plan, the *Draft Seaport Air Quality 2020 and Beyond Plan* (“*Draft Plan*”), to address emissions arising from equipment and operations at the Seaport, with a pathway to zero emissions. The *Draft Plan* builds upon the existing *Maritime Air Quality Improvement Plan* (“*MAQIP*”) that was adopted by the Board of Port Commissioners (“*Board*”) in 2009, and includes programs and projects that extend beyond the MAQIP’s Year 2020 planning horizon. Your comments are important to help us complete the *Final Seaport Air Quality 2020 and Beyond Plan* (“*Final Plan*”), which is scheduled to be presented to the Board in December 2018.
