FACTUAL BACKGROUND: PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACT AWARDS

General Building Contractor Services

On July 26, 2018, by Resolution No. 18-74, the Board authorized the Executive Director to execute up to four contracts for Furnishing Labor, Materials and Equipment for General Building Contractor Services for Port of Oakland Facilities for the Period Commencing January 1, 2019 and Ending December 31, 2019, 2020 or 2021, Oakland, California with the lowest responsible and responsive bidders based on informal bids, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 over the maximum three-year term of the contracts.

On October 30, 2018, the Chief Engineer (who currently also is the Director of Engineering) received three informal bids for the above work.

Accordingly, on November 7, 2018, the Executive Director approved the award of contracts for the above work to JUV, Inc., SDV Services, Inc. and SilMan Venture Corporation dba SilMan Construction. Because the work will be performed on a time and materials basis and the specific scope of work was unknown at the time of award owing to the as-needed nature of the contracts, the award was made on the basis of the contractor's markup on their direct costs for labor and materials in an aggregate amount not to exceed the above limit.

Electrical Work and Associated Services

On July 26, 2018, by Resolution No. 18-75, the Board authorized the Executive Director to execute up to four contracts for Furnishing Labor, Materials and Equipment for General Electrical Work and Associated Services for Port of Oakland Facilities for the Period Commencing January 1, 2019 and Ending December 31, 2019, 2020 or 2021, Oakland, California with the lowest responsible and responsive bidders based on informal bids, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$2,100,000 over the three-year term of the contracts.

On November 5, 2018, the Chief Engineer received eight informal bids for the above work.

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Accordingly, on November 26, 2018, the Executive Director approved the award of contracts for the above work to Columbia Electric, Inc., Gruendl, Inc. dba Ray's Electric, Shimmick Construction Company dba SCCI Electric, and St. Francis Electric, LLC. Because the work will be performed on a time and materials basis and the specific scope of work was unknown at the time of award owing to the as-needed nature of the contracts, the award was made on the basis of the contractor's markup on their direct costs for labor and materials in an aggregate amount not to exceed the above limit.

Land Surveying Services for Airport Grant Projects

On July 26, 2018, by Resolution No. 18-85, the Board authorized the Executive Director to execute one or more contracts for Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Professional Land Surveying Services for Airport Grant Projects at Oakland International Airport, based on the standard RFQ/RFP process in accordance with the Port Purchasing Ordinance, in a combined amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 for the maximum five-year term of the contract(s).

Three surveying firms submitted Statement of Qualifications (SOQs) on May 9, 2018. A panel comprised of Port staff evaluated the SOQs, based on each firm's qualifications, responsiveness to the requirements of the Request for Qualifications, relevant experience, the quality and experience of key project personnel, and the firm's technical abilities.

Upon final evaluation, Port Staff selected Towill, Inc. to receive a contract. A contract has been executed with the selected firm.

Land Surveying Services for Port Funded Projects

On July 26, 2018, by Resolution No. 18-86, the Board authorized the Executive Director to execute one or more contracts for Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Professional Land Surveying Services for Port Funded Projects at the Port of Oakland, based on the standard RFQ/RFP process in accordance with the Port Purchasing Ordinance, in a combined amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 for the maximum five-year term of the contract(s).

Four surveying firms submitted SOQs on May 9, 2018. A panel comprised of Port staff evaluated the SOQs, based on each firm's qualifications, responsiveness to the

requirements of the Request for Qualifications, relevant experience, the quality and experience of key project personnel, and the firm's technical abilities.

Upon final evaluation, Port Staff selected REY Engineers to receive a contract. A contract has been executed with the selected firm.
