BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORK: Installation of a sculpture on a new 6'x6' concrete pad adjacent to the Maritime Center building. The sculpture will serve as a memorial to merchant marine veterans, other mariners who have lost their lives at sea, and to all seafarers on ships coming into Oakland. The artist is Bosun James Allen King, an active seafarer and member of the Sailors Union of the Pacific. The proposed location is outside the 100-foot band but the applicant is responsible for obtaining BCDC approval if required. This project has been determined to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Sections 15303, Class 3(e), accessory structures.

SUSTAINABILITY: No sustainability measures are being considered outside the scope of this project.


