## Proposed Changes Coming to OAK Employee Parking

## Employee Parking Users,

We are reaching out to let you know that we are proposing to increase the current rate for Employee Parking Permits of $\$ 32$ monthly/ $\$ 96$ quarterly. This rate that has been in effect since 2008 and needs to increase to cover the rising costs of operating the employee parking program.

To minimize the financial impact of this increase, we propose to raise rates gradually over the next few years as shown in the table below:

As part of rolling out the rate increase, we will also be implementing features that will improve your experience with the employee parking program, including; Increased Hours of Operation, Prorated Permit Returns and Refunds, New Administrative Location, Digital Sign up Forms and Online Payment.

In this expensive region we acknowledge that price increases are not easy to manage and we want to hear from you. As an example, would billing for employee parking on a monthly vs. quarterly or annual basis help you manage your budgets?
