ORDINANCE AMENDING PORT OF OAKLAND ORDINANCE NO. 867 RATIFYING AND SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN NON-REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES OF THE PORT DEPARTMENT BELONGING TO PORT EMPLOYEE REPRESENTATION UNIT H.

Section 1. Section 1.2995 is hereby added to Port Ordinance No. 867 to read as follows:

Section 1.2995. The salary schedules set forth in Port Ordinance No. 867 for the following positions in Port Employee Representation Unit H shall be and the same are hereby amended by increasing the rates of compensation (base wages) set forth on said salary schedules by an additional three percent (3%) on, and retroactive to, the first day of the pay period containing January 1, 2020 and that the following amended salaries for the referenced unrepresented employee positions in Unit H are hereby ratified:
