

ORDINANCE AMENDING PORT OF OAKLAND ORDINANCE NO. 867 RATIFYING AND SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN NONREPRESENTED EMPLOYEES OF THE PORT DEPARTMENT BELONGING TO PORT EMPLOYEE REPRESENTATION UNIT H.

WHEREAS, the Board of Port Commissioners ("Board") has reviewed and evaluated the Agenda Report for Item 6.4 dated January 28, 2021 ("Agenda Report") and related materials, has received the expert testimony of Port of Oakland ("Port") staff, and has provided opportunities for and taken public comment; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Port Commissioners of the City of Oakland as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.2996 is hereby added to Port Ordinance No. 867 to read as follows:

Section 1.2996. The salary schedules set forth in Port Ordinance No. 867 for the following positions in Port Employee Representation Unit H shall be and the same are hereby amended by increasing the rates of compensation (base wages) set forth on said salary schedules by an additional three percent (3%) on, and retroactive to, the first day of the pay period containing January 1, 2021, and that the following amended salaries for the referenced unrepresented employee positions in Unit H are hereby ratified:

Section 2.
