

**PORT ORDINANCE NO. 4594**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING PORT OF OAKLAND ORDINANCE  
NO. 867 TO CREATE THE NEW CLASSIFICATION OF  
SAFETY AND BUSINESS CONTINUITY OFFICER.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Port Commissioners ("Board") has reviewed and evaluated the Agenda Report for Item 6.3 dated March 25, 2021 ("Agenda Report"), and related agenda materials, has received the expert testimony of Port of Oakland ("Port") staff, and has provided opportunities for and taken public comment; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Port Commissioners of the City of Oakland as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board hereby finds that this action was reviewed in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the CEQA Guidelines. The requested action, to enact an ordinance to create the new classification of Safety and Business Continuity Officer, is a personnel-related action and is not a project pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Sections 15060(c)(3) and 15378(b)(2), and no environmental review is therefore required.

**Section 2.** Section 5.0240 is hereby added to Port Ordinance No. 867 to create the classification of Safety and Business Continuity Officer, such classification assigned to salary grade 543.1 within said ordinance.

**Section 3.** In acting upon the matters contained herein, the Board has exercised its independent judgment based on substantial evidence in the record and adopts and relies upon the facts, data, analysis, and findings set forth in the Agenda Report and in related materials and in testimony received.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall take effect on the date of its final adoption; provided, however, that if a petition protesting the adoption of this Ordinance is timely and duly submitted to the elections official of the City of Oakland in the manner required under California Elections Code Section 9237, the effective date of this Ordinance shall be suspended, and all actions authorized by this Ordinance shall be null and void.
